**Needham, MA - Thursday, November 4, 2021** – Arlekin Players, an award-winning, artist-driven theater company rooted in traditions of classical and contemporary Russian theater and dedicated to imaginative storytelling and new forms of theater, is excited to announce the World Premiere of *WITNESS*, the newest virtual theater piece from their groundbreaking Zero Gravity (zero-G) Virtual Theater Lab. This bold and complex documentary theater piece bears witness to the migratory experience of Jewish people in the face of antisemitism and will be the first production of Arlekin's 2021-2022 season; previews will take place December 10 – 12, 2021 at 7:30PM ET with the World Premiere on Monday, December 13, 2021 at 7:30PM ET.

**WITNESS** was created through interviews and the use of historic materials, primarily sourced from the archives of the <u>United States Holocaust Memorial Museum</u>. It has been woven together into a dramatic documentary script by playwright Nana Grinstein (Moscow), with additional writing by dramaturg Blair Cadden and Arlekin's artistic director and **WITNESS** director Igor Golyak. The piece is inspired by the journey of the MS St. Louis, which left Hamburg in 1939 with over 900 Jewish people on board and headed to Cuba only to be turned away, leaving the passengers stranded with nowhere to go and no escape. **WITNESS** shares these stories through an interactive virtual theater experience at the nexus of film, theater and video games.

"We have been in an intense period of experimentation with virtual theater through the two productions we created during the pandemic (*State vs Natasha Banina* and *chekhovOS /an experimental game/*). We were able to reach audiences in over 40 countries which was incredible. *WITNESS* is the next step in our exploration, and for this show we are experimenting with a new combination of tools that may have not been used previously in the virtual theater medium." says Golyak. "We are creating *WITNESS* at a time when Jewish refugees around the world are having conversations around kitchen tables about the lack of safety, of belonging, of finding a home in the face of rising antisemitism. These are questions that Arlekin's resident company of actors, and our larger community, are asking: "Will my children be safe? What's the next pit stop? When do we start packing?" Because we are producing *WITNESS* virtually, we are able to invite audiences from across cultures and time zones to an interactive experience where they can encounter the stories of Jewish people migrating, fleeing persecution, and to engage in these questions with us. That's an extraordinary opportunity".

Set on a boat in the digital space, *WITNESS* includes multiple languages, stunning visuals, intimate stories, and critical moments of live choice by the audience throughout a live, interactive performance that will never be the same twice. The creative team includes artistic partners and technical experts collaborating across five countries; the cast features the Arlekin resident acting company with Gene Ravvin in the lead role, joined by a diverse group of voice actors, alongside Boston favorites Lauren Elias, Anne Gottlieb and Nathan Malin.

**Igor Golyak**, Director, is the founder and artistic director of Arlekin Players Theatre & Zero Gravity (zero-G) Virtual Theater Lab, "Best Director" Elliot Norton Winner 2020. His most recent projects, *chekhovOS /an experimental game/* and *State vs. Natasha Banina*, became international virtual theatre sensations, both earning *New York Times* Critic's Picks. Arlekin, an award-winning company of Russian immigrants, has performed all over the world, including Moscow Art Theatre, and festivals in Yerevan, Armenia, New York City, Chicago, Lviv, Ukraine, Monaco, the US, Canada and UK. Golyak recently directed Actors' Shakespeare Project's critically acclaimed production of *The Merchant of Venice*.

**Nana Grinstein**, Playwright, is based in Moscow and is known for her documentary theater projects including the celebrated "Coming Out", a play based on interviews and correspondences with real people. In addition to writing plays, she speaks and presents regularly about documentary theater, memory work in devising theater, and other topics at prominent theaters in Russia.

**Anna Fedorova,** Scenography & Costume Design, is a regular collaborator with Igor Golyak and Arlekin Players. She has worked in Moscow, St. Petersburg, Poland, Japan and Greece. She received the Theatre Spring 2017 prize for best scenography and costume design.

**Blair Cadden**, Dramaturg/Assistant Director, is a Boston-based director, deviser, dramaturg, and teaching artist. A recent graduate of the MFA directing program at Boston University, Blair previously co-founded and served as Artistic Director of 5th Wall Productions, located in her hometown of Charleston, South Carolina. Some favorite directing credits include *Red Bike, Time Stands Still*, and *Polaroid Stories* (Boston University); *Spring Awakening* (5th Wall Productions); and *The Last Days of Judas Iscariot* (Flowertown Underground). At Arlekin, she has served as dramaturg for *The Seagull* and assistant director for *chekhovOS /an experimental game/*.

**Sara Stackhouse**, Producer, is Managing Producer at Arlekin Players Theatre & Zero-Gravity (zero-G) Virtual Theater Lab where she co-produced *chekhovOS* /an experimental game/ and the international tour for *State vs Natasha Banina*. She is Founder and Principal at BroadBand Collaborative (Boston) and the Creative Director of The Mama Project (South Africa). She was Founding Executive Producer at Actors' Shakespeare Project, Chair of Theater at Boston Conservatory at Berklee, Supervising Producer, INSIDE This Old House/Time Warner, and Project Manager for cellist Yo-Yo Ma where she was on the producing team for the award-winning series *Yo-Yo Ma: Inspired by Bach*.

**Arlekin Players Theatre**, founded by Artistic Director Igor Golyak, was created in Boston in 2009 and has since toured to New York, Chicago, and Hartford, as well as to international festivals in Russia, Armenia, Ukraine, and Monaco. Arlekin received world-wide acclaim, including two New York Times Critic's Picks, for their groundbreaking virtual theater projects during the pandemic, including of <u>State vs Natasha Banina</u> and <u>chekhovOS /an</u> <u>experimental game/</u> featuring Mikhail Baryshnikov as Anton Chekhov. Arlekin has received multiple awards for its work including four 2020 Elliot Norton Awards from the <u>Boston Theater Critics Association</u> for its recent productions of *The Stone* and *The Seagull*. Arlekin takes strong pride in their emphasis on self-identity; they are a company of immigrants performing works that play on the ideas of cross-culture, home, and traditions, challenging

the idea of nationality, and finding common themes that unite us all. In 2020, Arlekin launched it's <u>Zero Gravity</u> (<u>zero-G</u>) <u>Virtual Theater Lab</u> to explore new theater possibilities for a new time. The company makes its home in Needham, MA.
